## **AGABUS PROJECT ~ PRAYER LABYRINTH**

During the Middle Ages, walking a labyrinth could substitute for a long, often dangerous pilgrimage to a place of religious significance. The prayer labyrinth offers us a metaphoric path to the mysterious center of God's heart. It is a time of contemplative reflection. It allows us an opportunity to surrender to the beckoning of the Holy Spirit to "come away with me by yourselves to a quiet place." (Mark 6:31). The purpose of the labyrinth is to remind us that God walks the path of life with us and He waits to meet us when we arrive at life's mysterious center. Please make time Friday afternoon or Saturday morning, January 15 and 16, to come and experience this spiritual pilgrimage. Come, "Be still and know" that he is God. (Psalm 46:10) This is unlike anything you've experienced before. The experience takes 30 ~ 45 minutes, but the results are lasting.
